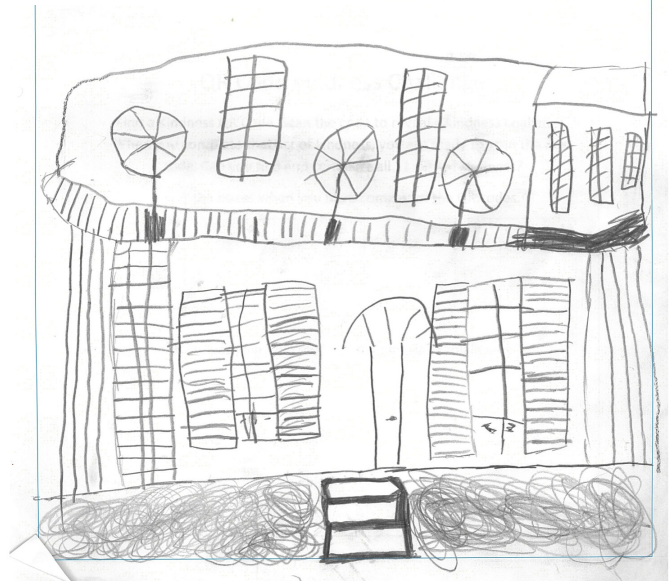

To keep cool we set up an outdoor classroom in a shaded area and set to work harvesting **Pak Choi** seeds. We talked about the life cycle of plants, what makes a fruit a fruit! and then set to work rolling and breaking the seed pods to release the seeds, to bag them up ready for planting next year.

We had an abundance of Woolworths Discovery Garden planting kits, so the students also planted lots of vegetable and flower seeds. We marvelled at the dehydrated soil pellets expanding as they met water. So much fun!

Head Lice

How do you get rid of them?

Once you've realised you've got head lice, you can get rid of them with lotions and shampoos from the chemist. One of the best ways to remove them, if you don't like the thought of using chemicals, is by wet-combing the hair with a special fine-tooth comb, but it needs to be done regularly and can take a long time to do thoroughly. Everyone with head lice in your household should be treated in the same day.



Prevention is better than cure

It pays to stay one step ahead. Regular combing with a fine comb will help early detection. Also keeping long hair tied up stops lice from grabbing hold of stray hairs and climbing onboard.
