I have just returned from the kitchen where Ilana, Mora Miriam and the students who attend Hebrew classes have been making Latkes to celebrate Chanukah. Each speech was outstanding – extremely well prepared and delivered with such heartfelt sincerity. The staff all commented on the maturity and integrity of our students. Next week, in each classroom, teachers will prepare our students for Presentation Day. Teachers will role play appropriate behaviour and responses for students who are not awarded prizes on the day. Teachers will also discuss how decisions about prizes are made at our school. Presentation Day can often be fraught with emotion. We believe if our students are well prepared it can be a positive experience.




An Important note from the office.







