Principal's Report

Dear Parents

On Easter Sunday morning at the *Bread of Life Program* in Surry Hills, it was a great privilege to be with our school leaders and their parents as they shared the Easter eggs that were collected by our school. The generosity of the Vaucluse community was very evident. Our school leaders met many of the homeless of Surry Hills and sent them off with not only eggs for themselves but gifts of eggs to share with their friends and families. The recipients of the eggs were extremely appreciative and overwhelmed at our school's generosity. They were delighted to have extra eggs to share. Our leaders were magnificent in their dignity and respect for the homeless. A very big thank you to the parents of our leaders who supported them to be present on Sunday morning to hand deliver the eggs. A huge thank you to the families of Vaucluse Public School who so generously supported the egg collection.

Our school leaders and I had a debrief session of the experience on Wednesday. One of the things that left an impression on all of us was the effect of being able to have enough of something to share with friends. We talked about how difficult it would be if you lived on the street and barely had enough for yourself let alone being able to share with your friends. We agreed it was something that we all take for granted, that is being able to share or give to others. Those homeless who received eggs on Sunday morning were delighted to be able to take something away and give to someone else. Our school leaders would like to continue to support the homeless of Surry Hills. They have activities planned for Term 2 and Term 3 so that they can contribute to the cost of food for the program.

Next week Parent / Teacher Interviews will take place for all class teachers. If you have not been able to book a time with your class teacher please contact the office and we will organise this for you. Term 1 Parent / Teacher Interviews are part of the Vaucluse PS Reporting to Parents Program.

We have had a number of issues with mobile phones of late. At Vaucluse PS we have a Mobile Phone Policy that requires signatures and permission from parents. Mobile phones must be signed and checked in to the admin office when students arrive at school and checked out when students leave. Students are not permitted to keep mobile phones in their bags or on them.

I have had an email from a concerned parent in regard to head lice in the school. It is that season again and it requires all of us to be vigilant and rigorous in the removal of nits. No amount of treating children's hair will work unless all parents are extremely careful in the removal of nits. It requires regular checking and vigilance. I know that many, many parents would appreciate all families keeping an eye on the small animal activity on our children's heads.

ETHICS CLASSES AT VAUCLUSE PUBLIC SCHOOL

Dear parents and carers,

Ethics classes are available in NSW public primary schools as an option for children who do not attend Special Religious Education (SRE). The NSW government has authorised Primary Ethics, a not-for profit organisation, to design curriculum and deliver these classes to children from kindergarten to year 6.

Children participate in discussion with their peers and learn how to think logically, disagree respectfully and support their arguments with evidence, rather than act according to habit or peer pressure.

Children discuss topics such as:

- imagining how others feel
- how do we treat living things?
- being an ethical consumer
- homelessness
- fairness

If you are interested in choosing Ethics for your child, please return the slip below by Monday

To enable us to meet demand for ethics classes at Vaucluse Public School we require volunteers-one for the position of ethics coordinator, and ethics teachers.

The ethics coordinator is an administrative role requiring approximately 1-2 hours per week. The time is flexible and the work and training are predominantly online.

Ethics teachers attend our 2 day training, complete the required background checks and take their class each week during school terms for a minimum of 1 year. The curriculum and teaching resources are provided online.

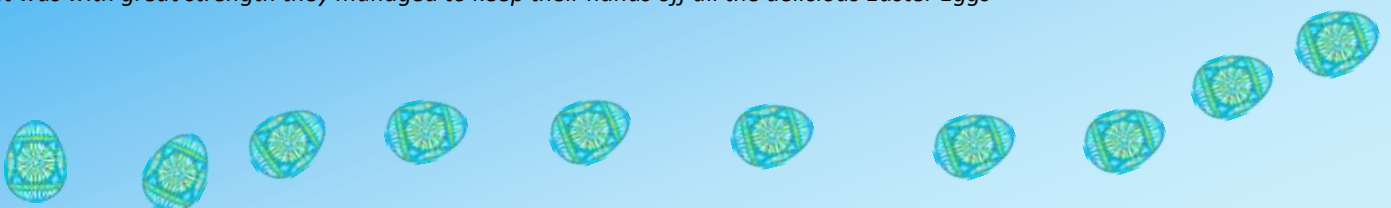

Term 2 – 2016 Extra-curricular Activities Update & Booking

Dear parents & carers,

Amazingly but true: Term 1/2016 is almost over, so it is time to get ready for Term 2. We are very excited to be sharing with you today the 3 new activities that we managed to organize

1. Coding
2. Soccer
3. Basketball

We have chosen those specific areas because they received the strongest expressions of interest from you. We hope to have managed to find providers that will be delivering to the high standard of student engagement set in previous terms. Below you can read some more information on the new activities and find the respective TryBooking links. Of course we are continuing to run the other activities such as Karate, Netball and Dancing. Those details are towards the end of this note.

Important: due to the number of sports activities that will be happening in the school grounds we ask all families for their cooperation:

- Only send those children that are enrolled in the activity: additional siblings will be UNSUPERVISED and therefore NOT COVERED by insurance.
- It is unfair for the enrolled children as the provider cannot concentrate in the children that actually pay for the activity.
- When you and your children arrive at school please respect that there are teaching sessions happening and stay off the area that is used (netball/basketball court or grass oval at front gate)

We have also updated the Terms & Conditions for the participation in the extra curricular activities. Before you can finalize your booking you have to tick the box that you agree to those Terms. Please take the time to read thoroughly.

Most important is the SIGNING IN/OUT procedure:

1. **Before school activities:** Parents are responsible for their child to arrive safely at the before school session and the child can and must sign in on the weekly roll call sheet if the parent is not present. Please make sure to answer “yes” to Student Sign In Permission when booking your activity.
2. **After school activities:** Parents are responsible for signing their child out from the weekly roll call sheet at the after school activities, they can give permission for their child to be collected by nominated contacts. Parents have to advise the Provider or parent coordinator in advance if any other person is authorized to collect your child. A child will not be released into the care of a minor (less than 18 years) and not to any person unless they have been specifically authorised by the parent and communicated to the Provider in advance. If a child will make its own way home parents will have to advise and discuss this with the Provider before the first session per term.

Please use this opportunity to book your child in early to avoid disappointment!

VPS Coding – delivered by Code Camp

Learning to code is more than 'becoming a developer.'

Code Camp allows students to be creative with technology, develop logical thinking, problem solving skills and an understanding of computational thinking.

Additionally, through 'app building' we focus on game design and the psychology of user experience and the entrepreneurship mentality. These skills can be adapted to any role in any industry.

The children use Stencyl, which is based on a drag and drop programming style very similar to Scratch. Through this we are able to introduce them to many of the concepts that are relevant to coding at any level, without having to spend too much time battling with syntax and for some their typing skills.

The process is to walk the class through a common game type, allowing the kids to include their own ideas and customisations along the way. Kids are able to design the characters, themes, backgrounds, sounds, music all to their own taste which leaves them with a real sense of ownership over what they've created. This form also allows us to introduce the kids to all the logic occurring when they play the games they do, which is normally a real eye opener. Stencyl also allows us to export to a number of different formats at the end of the camp so that every student can take their game home to continue creating.

In short our philosophy is to make this as fun as possible and to see the kids have tangible results as soon as possible, so that they're encouraged to do more once camp finishes, and also motivated to choose coding or technology subjects where offered in their future schooling.

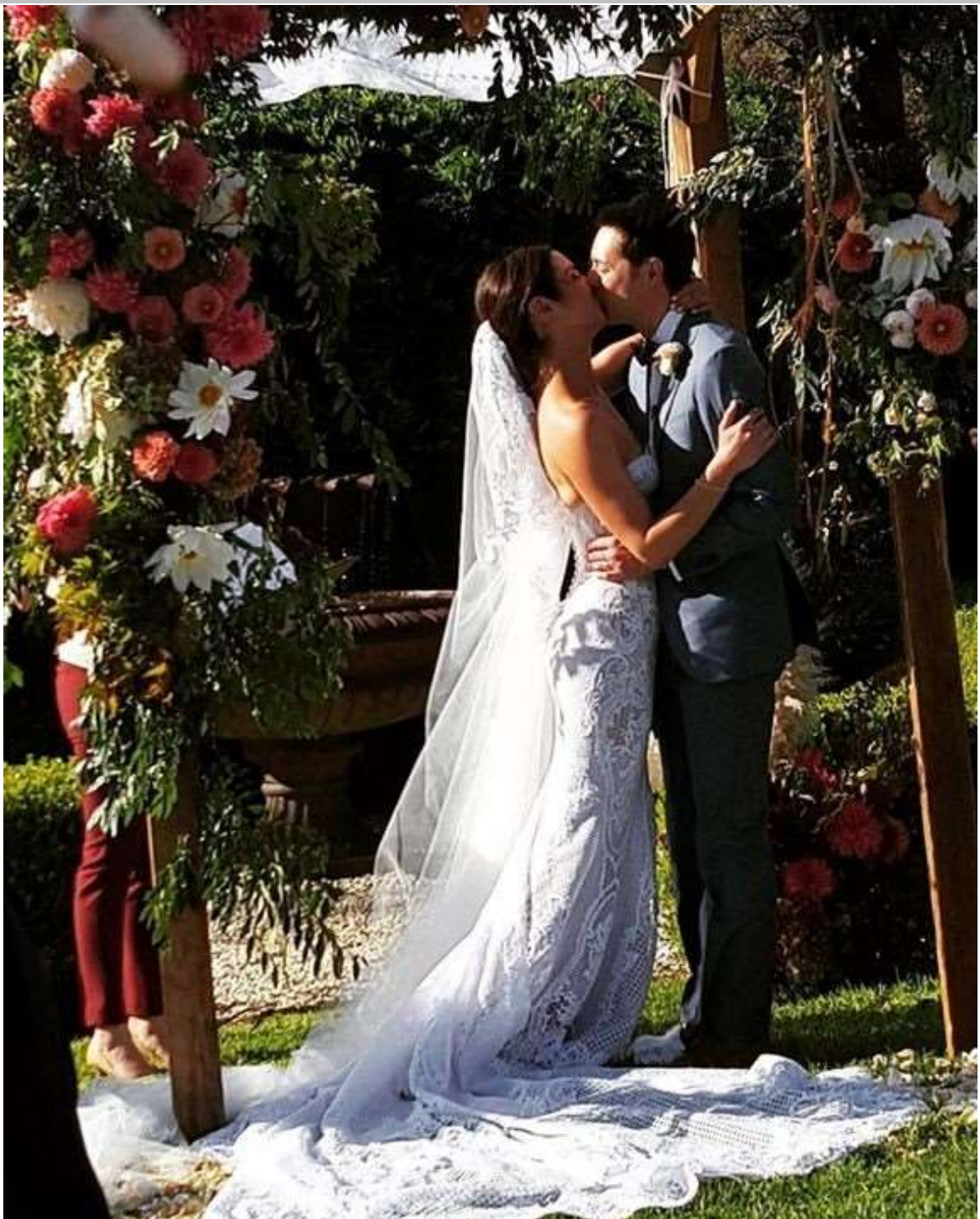
