# Principal's Report

Dear Parents

On Tuesday I had the great privilege to accompany the Year 6 Leaders to the RSL & Schools Remember Commemoration Service in Hyde Park. There were many schools represented from the government and non government sector. Our students laid flowers on the cenotaph with a message from our school community. They conducted themselves in a dignified and mature way that acknowledged and respected those we were remembering. We will be holding a special ANZAC Assembly on Thursday 28 April when school returns in Term 2. Teachers have been working with our students on the history of ANZAC and this assembly will be a culminating activity for these units of work.

The canteen tender process has been finalised this week. A new canteen operator will commence operating the canteen in Week 2 on Monday 2 May. 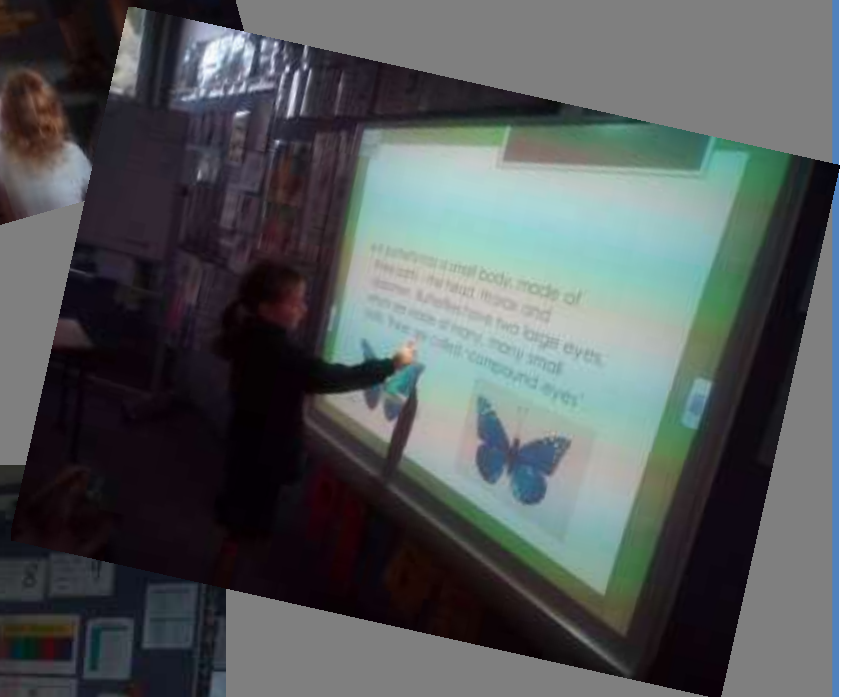




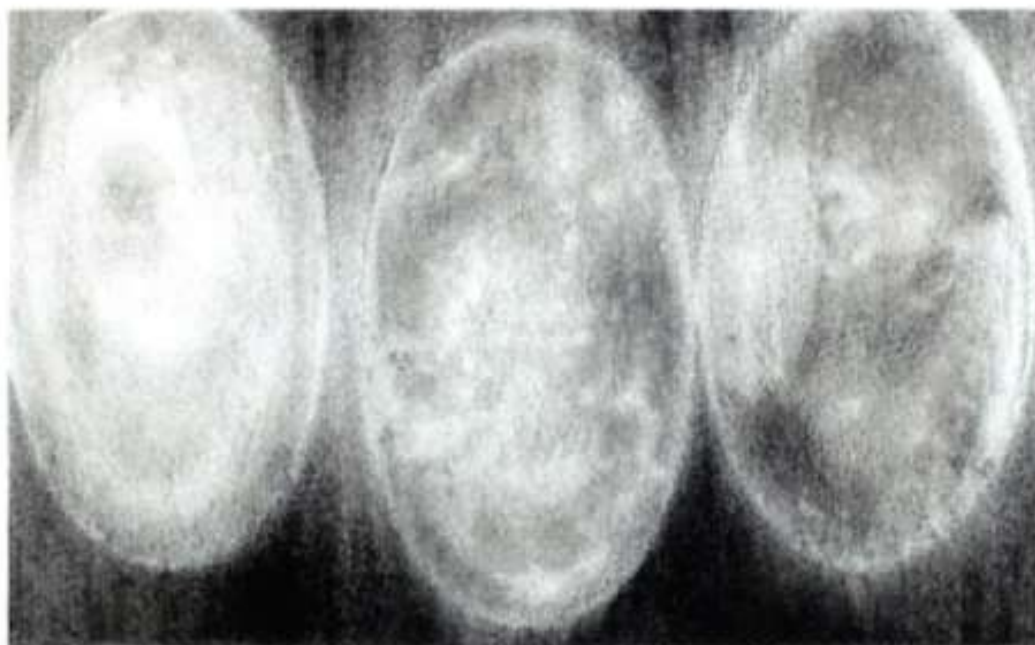

There will be no fee for this training and the only pre-requisite is that participants obtain a Working with Children Check (WWC) clearance and apply for a Department of Education employee number through their local school.

These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for opportunity class placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Opportunity Class Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Opportunity Class Placement Test will be held on Wednesday 27 July 2016.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2017, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a **valid email address (not the student's email address)**.

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from 26 April 2016 in a printed application information booklet and at [www.schools.nsw.edu.au/ocplacement](http://www.schools.nsw.edu.au/ocplacement). The application website opens on 26 April 2016 and closes on 13 May 2016. No late applications will be accepted.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after 26 April 2016.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.
