
On Wednesday we had 4 teams from Stages 2 & 3 represent VPS at a local Oz-tag carnival. They all played fantastically!

VPS Dance Auditions for 2023, taking place in Week 8!


Register for auditions now if you're in Year 2 -Year 5.

Vaucluse Public School Competition Troupe







All students currently in Years 2-5 are invited to audition for the Vaucluse Public School Competition Troupe who will represent the school in various competitions, including Sydney Eisteddfod, which is held at Sydney Opera House.

Audition Details

Students of all skill levels are encouraged to audition - prior training is not a prerequisite. Auditions will be held in Week 8 (dates and times listed below) in the School Hall.

Students are required to wear school uniform and jazz shoes (if they have) or bare feet. Students will participate in learning a short dance combination to be performed in groups of 3–5 and will be assessed on the following: ability to memorise with accuracy set dance steps, skill, technique, performance quality.

Program Cost

The yearly dance fee total is listed below. If your child receives a place in one of our REDed Troupes, payment in full is required by Tuesday 31 January, 2023, however monthly payment plans are available. This is a full year commitment.

Troupe Commitments

Dancers who are selected to join a troupe are required to commit to the following:

- 80% minimum attendance at weekly classes, with 100% expected (full year).
- Full attendance at our Term 1 and 2 Dance Intensives.
- Full attendance at all Eisteddfods, dates to be released early Term 1.
