

It's the thoughts that count...



Thinking plays a critical role in learning. However, thinking is often seen as an internal activity. So how do teachers tune into student thinking – to uncover misconceptions and to assess understanding instead of just performance? Say hello to number talks!

Number talks are short, whole-class discussions that allow students to talk and share ideas about numbers, explore number relationships, develop flexibility with numbers, and consider strategies they may not be familiar with.

At Vaucluse Public School we use number talks as part of our quality teaching practice. Teachers plan and scaffold number talks to deepen students' mathematical reasoning skills and conceptual understandings.

How can you uncover your child's mathematical thinking at home? Ask questions such as:

- \cdot What makes you say that?
- · How do you know?
- \cdot Can you prove it?
- \cdot Are there any other ways to solve this problem?

Last week, Mr McDonald got married! Stage 3 worked together to make and present him with a beautiful congratulations card!









Vaucluse Public School Works notification | 3 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We will be removing dead wood and leaf litter to prevent further blockage of the drain pit entry at Vaucluse Public School along the school boundary line adjacent to Cambridge Avenue.

This work will take place on the school site outside of school hours on the following days between 7 am and 1 pm:
